No more teachers? No more books? For today’s kids, the Internet has all the answers. Gadgets come and go and most of them don’t have a very long life. The Internet, however, seems to be here to stay. The World Wide Web is now the largest information resource in the world and teenagers can find more or less anything they want there. They can download music and films, watch TV, listen to the radio, send e-mails and even shop online

In this edition, we have brought some fascinating worksheets related to "adverb use" for grade 1 students. Adverbs help in the formation of prayers. They can also respond to different types of problems about how an operation was performed. Therefore, children should pay attention to these concepts.
